2025 Forest Park Country Club Swimming Pool Rules and Reminders

- 1. If there is No lifeguard on duty Swim at your own risk.
- 2. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a responsible person. Lifeguards will not be used as babysitters.
- 3. Swimsuits shall be required, no cut-offs, no thongs.
- 4. Daily Registration:
 - a) Daily Sign In: FPCC Pool Members and FPCC Members will register at the registration table daily.
 - b) Local Guest: If you have a guest, you must be present and pay \$10.00 for each guest you bring.
 - c) Non Local Guest: If you have a guest that lives a minimum of 40 miles from the club, a \$10.00 fee
 - is not required. This is a FPCC full member's privilege. Pool members do not have this privilege.
 - d) <u>Baby-Sitter Pass</u>: FPCC members and FPCC pool members may purchase a \$100.00 sitter pass. The pass may be used for multiple sitters, but only one babysitter at a time with the member's children present. (You can't have 2 or more sitters with one pass at the same time.) If you choose not to have a sitter pass, or the sitter is not a member you may continue to pay the guest fee.
- 5. No running or roughhousing on the pool deck.
- 6. No glass containers in or around the pool area.
- 7. One person allowed on the ladders and diving boards at a time.
- 8. No swimming under the diving boards.
- 9. Designated bathhouses at the end of the clubhouse are for members and guests using the pool.
- 10. Lifeguards have the authority to suspend members and guests for violating rules, from one hour to a full day. The lifeguard will then report the suspension to the Pool Management Volunteer or Club President.
- 11. Lifeguards can prohibit any individual from using the pool due to skin condition, open sores, illness, intoxication, etc.
- 12. Only lifeguards are allowed to connect to the speakers. If you have a play list you would like to have played, please share it with a lifeguard so that they can review the music to make sure it is appropriate for all ages.
- 13. You may bring food when the restaurant is not open.
- 14. Clean up after yourself let's keep the area pleasant for everyone.
- 15. Be respectful of others' space and enjoy the pool responsibly.
- 16. Children will be required to take a swim test. Lifeguards will test them and document their ability. They will inform the parents of the child's swim level and safety precautions.
- 17. Due to our ABC license, no outside alcohol is allowed. You may purchase alcohol from the pro shop or restaurant.
- 18. No smoking in the baby pool area.
- 19. All swimmers must respect pool breaks and time outs. Parents, please instruct your children to do so.
- 20. HAVE FUN, and don't forget your sunscreen!!
